Fundamentals in General Practice Nursing (2) with Digital Champion Programme

Develop your knowledge of working in general practice by undertaking this module from the University of Central Lancashire.

The content of these modules links to the Royal College of General Practitioners (RCGP, 2015) General Practice Nurse Competencies.

Fundamentals in General Practice Nursing (2)

Level 6 (20 credits)

This module aims to prepare nurses to develop knowledge and skills which will enable them to meet the needs of current challenges facing general practice, utilising nationally recognised frameworks. It aims to enhance nurses' existing expertise and develop new areas of competence in support of their professional development.

Fundamentals in General Practice (2)

Level 7 (20 credits)

This module aims to allow nurses to explore their knowledge and skills which will enable them to critically consider meeting the needs of current challenges facing general practice, utilising nationally recognised frameworks. It aims to enhance nurses existing expertise and critically explore and develop new areas of competence in support of their professional development.

This is the core module for the BSc (Hons) and MSc Nursing in General Practice.



Digital Champion Programme

With NHS England and NHS Improvement,

Funding has been made available for students to undertake the Digital Champion Programme in combination with the Fundamentals in General Practice Nursing (2) at the University of Central Lancashire.

The course addresses the need for nurses to develop skills in technology enabled care services (TECS) and has been designed to up-skill the general practice workforce from any level of digital literacy and there have been amazing results from those taking part on the programme.

Learning Outcomes

- More efficient and creative ways of managing workflows and engaging with patients
- Increased knowledge of, and confidence using TECS routinely in practice
- Improved organisational communication and patient satisfaction

The Course

The programme consists of 2 sessions which are incorporated within Fundamentals in General Practice Nursing (2). It is compulsory for students to attend both the initial and final session of the Digital Champions Programme. Participants will be presented with all relevant information, and develop action plans, before being provided with ongoing and on-the-ground support throughout their journeys.

Nurses will be provided with equipment (including a tablet) to help them use technology to support their patients, making the process as easy and effective as possible.

Start Dates

The Fundamentals in General Practice (2) with Digital Champion Programme will run over 12 weeks, with teaching carried out every other week (6 full day teaching sessions 9am - 4pm) followed by an assessment.
