Expression of Interest (Eoi) Process for Multi-Professional Advanced Practitioner - Closing midday 15th March 2021.

Health Education England has made significant investments in supporting the development of Advanced Practitioners. Given workforce transformation requirements, implications of Sustainability and Transformation Partnership (STP) and Integrated Care Systems (ICS) plans, it is expected that there will be further growth for the demand of Advanced Practitioner development.

HEE is now inviting applications for potential Advanced Practitioner funding for the academic year 2021/2022 (autumn 21 and spring 22 cohorts). Further information can be found in the **AP Principles 2021-22**.

In order to complete an Expression of Interest, organisations need to:

- 1) Read the **AP Principles 2021-22**

- 2) Complete the [Electronic Expressions of Interest Form](#)
- 2) Submit a Job Description for the role on qualification
- 3) Submit a Person Specification for the role on qualification

The submission deadline is **15th March 2021** (Midday)

Important points to note:

- The electronic form **cannot be saved** prior to submitting so please make sure you have all the information needed before you complete (details of role, funding route, preferred Education Provider etc.)
- One form is required for each service area
- EoIs will only be accepted if all three documents are completed/provided.
- You must ensure all relevant information is completed in the form
- You must ensure the form is completed by a designated Advancing Practice Lead

The outcome of the EoI Process will be communicated in May 2021.
