



Primary Care Imms and Vaccs Support Introduction to Childhood Immunisation (2 days)

This is essential 2 day training for practice nurses new to childhood immunisation and for nurses delivering or advising on childhood immunisation in other healthcare settings. The content of this 2 day event is based on the National Minimum Standards for Immunisation Training (HPA, 2018)

Day 1

1. Discuss history of vaccination
2. Discuss COVER
3. Complete immunisation schedule worksheet
4. Identify sources of vaccine information and guidance
5. Discuss vaccine immunology
6. Identify vaccines by generic name
7. Discuss the different vaccine types
8. Take part in group work to identify signs and symptoms and long-term effects of vaccine preventable disease
9. Discuss the national programme and identify current issues

Day 2

1. Consolidation of day 1 information
2. Complete exercise on vaccination of children with uncertain vaccination status
3. Discuss vaccine administration
4. Identify signs and symptoms of Vaccine associated adverse events/ anaphylaxis
5. Complete cold chain activity
6. Identify contra indications/precautions
7. Discuss PGD's/PSD's
8. Discuss clinic management
9. Name legal and policy documents associated with immunisation
10. Discuss consent issues/risk communication

Practical competency and ongoing supervision should be assessed within the working environment by an experienced mentor.
