The following UK registered healthcare professionals are eligible to train to undertake the role of cervical sample taker:

- Registered Nurses
- Registered Nursing Associates
- Physician Associates who are registered on the Physician Associate Managed Voluntary Register (PAMVR)

The benefits of Cervical Smear Screening can never be understated, ensuring the patient is guided through the process and feels calm and assured is paramount. Training is vital for this important role.

All sections of the application form marked Mandatory need to be completed. All Novice Smear Takers require an in house Smear Mentor and an external assessor.

PLEASE NOTE that applicants :

MUST have a Smear Mentor within their practice who will mentor them and who has completed specific Smear Mentor Training with either Manchester or Liverpool Universities within the last 3 years and have also completed Smear Update Training within the last 3 Years.

The Smear Mentor will need to provide their Name, Email Address, NMC number and the date that they completed their Smear Mentor Training and the date of their Smear Update Training.

The locality Training Hub will allocate their external assessor.

If any applicant does not have a practice smear mentor this can be completed via a 2.5 Hour Online Training Module. Please see our Smear Mentor/Assessor Training Information Leaflet.
